



## SOUTH DISTRICT TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP (DRENNAN SALVER) – 2010

### CONDITIONS OF PLAY

#### 1. GENERAL

##### 1.1 Eligibility of Teams

Teams will consist of 8 players representing each of the 3 Districts of the South Area.

##### 1.2 Eligibility of Players

All players nominated to teams by their District Associations must:

- a) be male at birth and of Amateur Status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- b) be a member of a recognised golf club affiliated to the Scottish Golf Union.
- c) only represent the District to which the player's Home Club is affiliated.
- d) not have represented another District in the current year.
- e) be in possession of a handicap under the current CONGU Unified Handicapping System.

**Penalty for Breach of Condition:** Disqualification of player.

##### 1.3 Format

3 teams A, B & C shall be eligible to participate and each shall comprise 8 players. The designation of these teams will be that the hosting district will be team A and then the district due to host the following year will be team B and the remaining district will be team C. The hosting of the championship will rotate around the 3 districts equitably.

The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

The format of the competition will be match play played over 18 holes. 1 point will be awarded for a win and ½ point for a draw. The morning round will be in the form of foursomes. The two first named pairs of players of team A will play the two first named pairs of players of team B. The two first named players of team C will play the second two pairs of players from team B. The second two pairs of players from team A will play the second two pairs of players from team C.

The afternoon round will comprise 12 singles matches. The first 4 players in team A will play the first 4 players in team C. The first 4 players in team B will play the second 4 players in team C. The second 4 players in team A will play the second 4 players in team B.

The winning team will be that team which has accumulated the highest points' total. In the event of a tie the named player in the tying teams would play sudden death to a conclusion. The named player in each team must be indicated on the team sheet which is handed to the organiser prior to the start of play. No substitutes will be allowed once the team sheet has been submitted. Any withdrawals after the team sheet has been submitted, for whatever reason, will result in that match being forfeit and the point/s awarded to the opposing team.
